Maritime Usage Licence:

Part 5 (sections 110 to 133) of the Maritime Area Planning Act 2021 (MAPA) provides for the granting of maritime usage licences.

Section 112 of the Act states that the Maritime Area Regulatory Authority (MARA) is the competent authority for the purposes of Part 5 of the European Communities (Birds and Natural Habitats) regulations 2011 (S.I No. 477 of 2011) and appropriate assessments to which that Part applies.

Section 114 of the Act states that the Minister may by regulations provide for class of Schedule 7 usage to be exempted usage for the purposes of this Part.

<u>Schedule 7</u> of the Act lists the Maritime Usages that may be undertaken in the maritime area pursuant to licence.

<u>Schedule 8</u> of the Act lists the types of conditions that MARA may attach to a licence.

2.2 Description of proposed Maritime Usage.

The proposed maritime usage is for maintenance dredging of the entrance channel (Area A) and the southern part of the Graving Dock (Area B).

The objective of the project is to dredge Area A and B to -5.5 mCD to ensure that the naval fleet can safely navigate.

The dredging works are crucial to allow the naval base to remain operational.

Maintenance dredging of the basin and entrance channel takes place approximately every 5 to 6 years to ensure the safe navigation of the naval fleet in the Haulbowline Naval Base, with the last Maintenance dredging campaign performed in 2017.

2.3 Describe the nature and scale of any structure to be erected in the maritime area.

The proposed works do not involve the construction of any new structures. The application is for a licence for the dredging of sediments (silts and sands) within the Haulbowline Naval base.

2.4 Indicative timing of the works/activity: (i) Start date (ii) Duration (iii) Any other information relevant to timing.

A licence is sought to run from 1st January 2025 to 31st December 2032 inclusive. Work undertaken during this period will be dictated by weather patterns and the associated sedimentation incurred in the entrance channel, Basin and Graving Dock.
